

# What's Recyclable?

## ✓ Acceptable Items



### Plastics

Recycle plastics #1, #2 and #5. Look on the bottom of containers for the number inside the recycling arrows.



### Metal Cans

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans—steel, tin, and aluminum.



### Cardboard, Newspaper & Magazines

Recycle newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



### Paper Food Containers & Cartons

Egg cartons (plastic or cardboard), cereal and pasta boxes.



### Paper

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders.



### Glass

Recycle clear, brown and green bottles and jars.



**Don't bag it!** Put your recyclables loose in your recycling cart.



Please make sure your recyclables are **empty, clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.
