Acceptable Items



Plastics

Recycle plastics #1, #2 and #5. Look on the bottom of containers for the number inside the recycling arrows.



Metal Cans

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans—steel, tin, and aluminum.



Cardboard, Newspaper & Magazines

Recycle newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



Paper Food Containers & Cartons

Egg cartons (plastic or cardboard), cereal and pasta boxes.



Paper

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders.



Glass

Recycle clear, brown and green bottles and jars.



Don't bag it! Put your recyclables loose in your recycling cart.

Please make sure your recyclables are **empty**, **clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.
